### CONSTANTIN FLONDOR

b. 1936, Cernăuti, Ukraine lives and works in Timisoara / RO

A pioneering artist, Constantin Flondor is a central figure of Romania's postwar avant-garde. He co-founded the artist collectives 1+1+1 (1966–1969), Sigma (1969–1981), and Prolog (active since 1985), groups that explored experimental intersections between art, science, and pedagogy.

As director and co-founder of a progressive educational program at the Art Lycée in Timişoara (1969–1975), Flondor helped shape a new generation of artists by integrating mathematics, cybernetics, and constructivist principles into visual arts education. Since 1993, he has also served as a visiting professor at the Beratzhausen summer schools in Germany, continuing his commitment to collaborative learning and exchange.

Flondor's practice is deeply informed by constructivist thinking and a rigorous interest in systems and algorithms. In both his solo works and collective projects, each element functions like a data unit within a larger visual equation, resulting in compositions that are simultaneously rational and poetic. His works often investigate the relationship between para-architectural forms and their environment, considering how structures interact with space, light, and perception.

Through his decades-long career, Flondor has bridged art, science, and pedagogy, proposing a model of artistic practice that is both analytical and contemplative, seeking to decode the world while remaining open to its mystery.
